Employability Assessments

We have integrated a variety of assessment tools, including CoCubes and eLitmus. These evaluations have proven instrumental in appraising their aptitude and technical proficiency, thereby ensuring they are thoroughly prepared to fulfill professional exigencies.

CoCubes Employability Assessment I – 2026 Batch

The CoCubes assessment, conducted on the 5th and 26th July 2025, experienced substantial participation of 1,061 and 566 aspiring engineers, respectively, in their quest to enhance their placement preparedness.



eLitmus Employability Assessment I – 2026 Batch

Our ongoing endeavors, which include assessing both the technical and aptitude competencies, eLitmus Assessment-I was administered to 1,087 engineering students on 4th July 2025, followed by an additional batch of 458 engineering students on 19th July 2025.



Placement Preparatory Assessment

By the same token, to adapt a comprehensive approach to the assessment, Placement Preparatory Assessments were meticulously crafted to evaluate the technical, logical, and analytical proficiency of students. These evaluations were conducted on 18th and 21st July 2025 for 714 students of 2026 Year of Passing (YOP).



Employability Enhancement Training

Employability Enhancement Training equips students with necessary soft skills, advanced communication proficiency, and industry-relevant acumen to augment their job preparedness. This program emphasizes the refinement of interview techniques, the art of resume crafting, and the enhancement of overall workplace efficacy.

Career Competency Training

The Career Competency Training (CCT) Phase II for the 2026 YOP was conducted from 9th July 2025 to 29th July 2025, equipping 633 students with vital competencies for successful placement. The training encompassed comprehensive sessions on quantitative aptitude, logical reasoning, verbal proficiency, and problem-solving acumen fastidiously designed to elevate participants' performance during interviews.







A series of initiatives were conducted in July 2025 to strengthen placement readiness among students. CCT Weekly Assessments were held on 3rd July 2025 for the 2026 YOP, engaging 633 students from diverse engineering disciplines to evaluate and develop essential skills aligned with industry expectations. In addition, mock interviews were organized for 633 students on 23rd, 24th, 25th, 29th, and 30th July 2025, inclusive of both behavioral and technical rounds. These sessions provided a wholesome simulated interview experience, enhancing students' confidence and preparedness for upcoming placement processes.







Career Counselling and Guidance Cell

Induction cum Acquaintance Program – July 2025

The School of Freshman Engineering organized an Induction cum Acquaintance (IcA) Program from July 11th to July 29th 2025. This initiative welcomed 27 cohorts of first-year students from diverse disciplines, including the School of Computing (SoC), School of Electrical and Communication Engineering (SoEC), School of Mechanical and Civil Engineering (SoMC), School of Management (SoM), and School of Commerce (SCOM).

The IcA introduced a series of insightful sessions delivered to foster career awareness among students. These sessions highlighted the importance of strategic career planning, explored diverse career pathways, and emphasized the essential skills required for achieving professional success.

Additionally, the program introduced the Graduate Aptitude Test in Engineering (GATE) Examination. This served as an early orientation for students interested in pursuing higher studies, research, and varied competitive opportunities.



This interaction marked an important step in deepening our partnership with Matrimony.com and aligning efforts toward mutual growth and student success.






HDFC - TPO Meet












Students' Corner
